Welcome to the Parish of St Peter's Henleaze

Christian funerals can be an occasion of both sadness and sometimes great joy. While we mourn the loss of a loved one, we can rejoice in the promise the Lord gave us. Therefore, we attach great importance to conducting funerals within the Parish of St Peters.

There are many advantages of having a service at church

- We can accommodate large numbers
- The length of the service is not restricted.
- We are very flexible with regards to the day and time for the service to be held.
- The service can precede or follow the committal with the same Minister.

While we welcome families contacting our Church office for advice, your first point of contact should be through a Funeral Director.

The Funeral Director will help you with all the necessary paperwork, be able to give you advice on the type of Funerals available to you, and book the Minister on your behalf.

Should you choose to go ahead with a service in Church, your details will be passed to us by your Funeral Director. Once received, a member of our Ministry or Lay team will contact you, and an appointment will be made for you to meet and discuss the service details.

Arrangements for all funeral services held by us will include:

- A meeting with the next-of-kin and family members.
- Planning the Funeral Service- Music, Readings and Prayers, the Eulogy & Lighting Candles
- Conducting the Funeral Service.
- Follow-up Pastoral care with a member of our very experienced Pastoral Team, to give you help and support following the funeral

Refreshments following the Service

If you wish to provide refreshments following the Service you may use the Church or if available the Church Hall.

A new drinks servery is available in the church which is equipped with crockery and dishwashing facilities.

There is an additional fee of £30 per hr for the hire of the church and a set fee of £15 for the use the servery.
